Regina v Kevin Brown and others (January – March 2007)

High profile armed robbery case at Woolwich Crown Court. Firstly as Leading Counsel and then as a Junior when legal aid was extended for a Q.C.

Regina v Damion Ennis and others (November – December 2006)

Central Criminal Court. Leading Junior brief for the first Defendant in a case of armed robbery and murder.

Regina v Daniel Buchanan and others (September 2006)

Inner London Crown Court. Leading Junior for the first Defendant in a serious case involving allegations of kidnapping, false imprisonment and torture.

Regina v Robert Mohid and others (December 2005)

Birmingham Crown Court representing the first Defendant in month long armed robbery trial.

Regina v Deon Montague and others (September 2005)

Kingston Crown Court. Leading Junior brief for fourth Defendant in a major cocaine importation conspiracy.

Regina v McDonnell and others (April 2005)

Leeds Crown Court representing second Defendant in major drugs importation case.

Regina v Craig Moran and Others (February – March 2005)

Stafford Crown Court representing one of the Defendants in the murder / armed robbery case involving the death of Nottingham jeweller Marion Bates.

Regina v Watson and Shakespeare (September 2005)

Junior brief in murder case involving brutal drive by shooting after a car chase between Nottingham and Leicester.

Regina v John Lambert and others (August – October 2005)

Lincoln Crown Court. Leading Junior brief in the trial that arose out of the Lincoln Prison Riot.

Regina v Tabassum and others (May 2003 - March 2004)
